

Introduction to Teamlink

Teamlink is Pacific Coast Amateur Hockey Association's game management system. It is an internet-based system, accessible to everyone with an internet connection.

The address for the Teamlink website is www.teamlink.ca. You can also access Teamlink through the PCAHA website at www.pcaha.bc.ca, and then click on Teamlink.

There are sections of the system that are open to the public, and anyone can view these reports. Typically, you can view the standings, team record and basic team information without having to login. For the game result entry, viewing some reports and general game schedule maintenance, you will have to have logged onto the system to perform these functions.

Teamlink originally started in 2005 with a concept to make it easier for League Managers and Managing Directors to do their tasks in a central location, and to make available the latest standings to the general public. This would replace the manual process in place at the time, and would give access to standings at any time. In that first season (2005-2006), it was only used to keep track of the Midget A group of teams. The second season (2006-2007), Midget C and the Bantam division (A and C) were added to the system. The following season (2007-2008), Juvenile A along with the whole Peewee division were included. The Atom division was added for the 2008-2009 season. Hockey 4 group was added for the 2011-2012 season. Finally, the Hockey 1 - 3 groups were included for the 2012-2013 season.

During the 2012-2013 season, over 31,300 players and team staff were active in the Teamlink system, and there were over 25,700 games processed.
